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COUNCIL PROCEEDINGS OCTOBER 5, 2020

Council Members Dee Roberts, Wm Ian Farrell, Chris Halpin, Colby Rogers, Ryan Porter, Heidi Worlton and Steve Jones were present for the regularly scheduled City Council meeting at 6:00 PM on the 5TH of October 2020 via ZOOM due to the COVID-19 virus. Officers present were Clerk/Treasurer Gretchen Sagen, Public Works Director Eric Weiberg, Fire Chief Todd Strozyk, Police Chief Chuck Spoor and City Attorney Joel Penoyar.

Mayor Tony Nordin called the meeting to order and did a roll call. Council Member Ryan Porter made a motion to approve the minutes of September 21, 2020 meeting, the Agenda and Consent Agenda for tonight's meeting. The motion was seconded by Council Member Roberts and passed with all members present voting aye.

DEPARTMENT HEAD REPORTS

Fire Chief Todd Strozyk announced that Zak McDougall and Cameron Cogdill had their one-year anniversary and are off probation. Todd also informed the Council he would like to run a bond for a new fire engine in 2021. The cost of the election is \$8,000. We will need to have an Ordinance in place by 2nd week of December 2020.

Police Chief Chuck Spoor informed the Council that the new Police Department is moving ahead. He also thanked the Council for their support on the purchase of the new building.

Public Works Director Eric Weiberg announced that the Public Works Crew had been busy putting new water lines in the Hewitt addition and prepping the site at GH College for the new playground equipment. Council Members Jones, Porter and Farrell had questions for Eric regarding lighting at the Waterfront dock area, striping on parking lot and Willapa Hills Trail.

Clerk/Treasurer Gretchen Sagen announced there will be a budget meeting on Wednesday, October 7, 2020 at 4PM at Council Chambers. She also went over end of month fund balances and current expense is holding its own even with the purchase of the new Police Department.
