To the Citizens of the City of Raymond:

As Mayor of the City of Raymond, I want you all to know that our City Council and Staff are all very aware of how COVID-19 pandemic has and could affect us.

Precautions are being taken to protect our personnel by closing the City Hall lobby for foot traffic. We are now requiring business to be performed by phone or use of the drop box adjacent to the southern side of the building. Contingency plans are being developed for any potential reduction or loss of services due to staff losses caused by the virus.

The City will continue to do business as usual by supplying drinking water, wastewater treatment, garbage collection, police service and fire and/or ambulance services with additional virus precautions. Our City parks will be open to the public with the personal guidelines mandated by the Pacific County Health Department.

City Council Meetings will be meeting by teleconference and the proceedings will be recorded and posted to our city website.
