

**RESOLUTION #1246**

**A RESOLUTION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAYMOND  
GRANTING PRELIMINARY APPROVAL OF THE UPDATED WATER SYSTEM  
COMPREHENSIVE PLAN AND DIRECTING THE STAFF TO FORWARD THE  
DOCUMENT WITH ALL SUPPORTING MATERIALS TO THE WASHINGTON  
STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH OFFICE OF DRINKING WATER FOR REVIEW  
AND APPROVAL**

**WHEREAS**, WAC 246-290-100, Group A Public Water Supplies, requires the city of Raymond to develop and implement a Water System Comprehensive Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the city of Raymond adopted its current Water System Comprehensive Plan in 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, the State Department of Health requires all jurisdictions in the state to periodically update their Water System Comprehensive Plans; and


**WHEREAS**, the city of Raymond City Council held a public hearing on November 21, 2016 to take and record public comments related to the updating of the Water System Comprehensive Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RAYMOND, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The City Council approves the 2016 Water System Comprehensive Plan attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference. Staff is directed to forward this Resolution to the Department of Health Office of Drinking Water for review and approval as required by WAC 246-290-100.
2. The Water System Comprehensive Plan approved by this Resolution shall not become final and effective until the City Council reviews the Department of Health's findings and conclusions, and adopts, with any changes resulting from the process outlined in RCW 246-290-100, by ordinance.
3. Staff is authorized to correct any typographical errors, spelling, formatting, or codification and to make other minor revisions to improve reader's comprehension of the document provided that any revisions do not alter the regulatory meaning and intent and provided further that said edits are shown at the time of ordinance adoption.
