- Clerk-Treasurer MacIntosh presented the council with the 2nd Qtr. financial report as well as the proposed 2026 budget calendar.

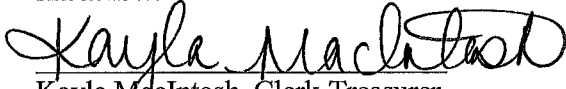
